Since we began in March 2020, we are proud to have achieved the following: Around 3,400 Shopping and Prescription deliveries, 4,250 Hot Meals, 380 Kindness Boxes and Christmas Gift bags, 2,350 Listening Ear calls, 1,300 Shop Queue hours, 320 hours of Dog Walking, 150 hours Gritting and Path Clearance and 250 Afternoon Teas.

We estimate that our total volunteer offer in that period amounts to 5,300 hours. We are still here for our community and will continue as long as there is a demand.
