Safety Advice for Volunteers

Coronavirus

<u>Please</u> Don't try and do your shift if you are feeling ill

Maintain social distancing at all times

Minimise contact with surfaces when delivering

Don't enter people's houses, unless asked by a member of the BCAG committee to do so, or if deemed necessary to fulfil the task, or in an

emergency

Wear a mask when social distancing of 2m is not practical Sanitise phones when passing them on to another volunteer

Use of Vehicles

<u>Please</u> Be aware that you are using your car at your own risk and are solely

responsible for any insurance claims that may arise

Make sure that your car is roadworthy and that you have fuel in it!

<u>Please</u> Don't try to carry something that's too heavy for you

Keep an eye out for moving traffic

Back off if you encounter any aggression from service users

Be aware of any farm animals when you are delivering

Watch where you are going and be aware of uneven surfaces
